Today you may notice the prayer request cards have been replaced with a new blue prayer card. These new cards will ensure that we have effective prayer & pastoral care follow-up for all of our parishioners & their loved ones. The cards can be filled out & placed in the collection plate or given to any usher. The list of prayer recipients will be compiled & prayers for these individuals will be included in the Prayers of the People in following weeks. The prayer list will be shared with intercessors so that daily prayers can be offered for these individuals. We understand that this process is different from the way we have recently handled prayer requests, & we believe this will be even more effective. This change is being implemented in response to several individuals who received prayer requests initially for an ailment or issue, & never received pastoral care follow up. We hope that by instituting this new system, we as a congregation & clergy team are better able to meet the spiritual & pastoral needs of all of our congregants.
